


AHKAM OF TRAVELLERS & TRAVELLING



PRAYERS

All 4-Rakaat prayers become 2 Rakaat



FASTING

A traveller doesn't have to fast

NO FASTING



If he's fasting and he travels after the Adhan of Zuhr, he must keep his fast for that day

What is the limit of **Tarakhus**?

A traveller starts applying Ahkam of travelling once he's reached the limit of Tarakhus, which is a place where people of the city do not see the traveller, and he does not see them

WHERE IS MY HOMETOWN?



The term "hometown" in Ahkam has a different meaning to the commonly used word.

Number one: hometown is the place that one belongs to, and usually is his birthplace and it's the home of his parents



Number two: it's the place one chooses to spend the rest of his life in



Number three: it's the place one adopts for his residence for a long period of time; for example for studying or working thus he's not considered a traveller there



Number four: it's the place that one stays in regularly for a significant period of time so he is not considered as a traveller there



Do you need to own or rent a house in a place to consider it as your hometown?

No, not necessarily. A hometown is a place where you reside for a long period of time, and thus you are no longer considered as traveller there



WHAT IS TRAVEL IN AHKAM?

1

The distance covered must be at least 44 kilometers

44 Km/ 27.34 miles

It can be the outbound and return together

It is the path travelled & not the straight geographic distance or radius



It's usually measured from the end of the hometown

2

One should have the intention to cross the legal distance from the beginning of his journey



3

One shouldn't face what breaks the Ahkam of legal travelling during his journey



1. If you reach your hometown and stop in it, your travel is terminated. For the continuation of the journey, you have to reset the distance measurement from this place

2. If you decide to stay at a place for 10 continuous days, this will break the travel and you become a resident or Moqim

A Moqim should behave as if he's at his hometown

3. If you arrive at a place and are not sure about staying for 10 days, you should behave as a traveller for up to 30 days. After 30 days, the condition of travel is broken and you become a resident or Moqim
