Match each message to the stamp to find out who sent the letter, and circle the letter that was NOT sent to Imam Hussain (a.s).






Who is buried where?







Imam Hussain (a.s) was the last member of the family to go out to fight on the battlefield on Ashura day.





Make an origami version of Zuljina by cutting out a square piece of paper and following the instructions below.




The thirst of Bibi Sakina (s.a)






