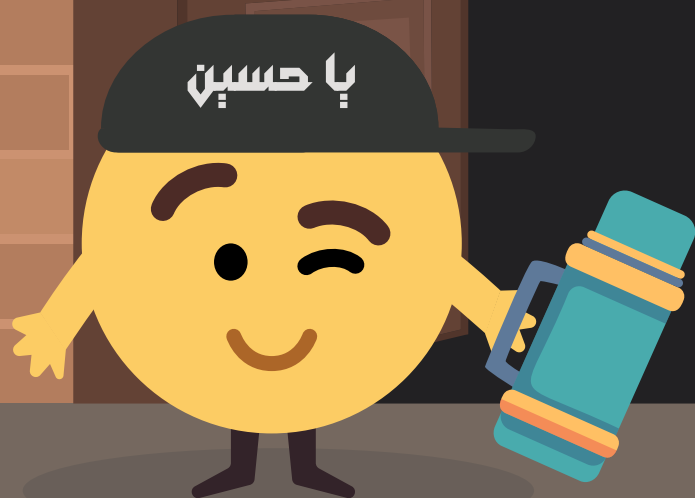

Muslim ibn Aqeel (a.s)

After receiving thousands of letters from the people of Kufa, Imam Hussain (a.s) asked Muslim ibn Aqeel (a.s) to travel to the city to learn more about the situation. Upon arriving Muslim found that people left the cause of Imam Hussain (a.s).

Aun and Muhammad

Hazrat Aun and Hazrat Muhammad (a.s) were the brave young sons of Bibi Zainab (s.a) who stood on Ashura alongside their uncle Imam Hussain (a.s).

Hurr ibn Yazid ar-Riyahi (r.a)

Hurr ibn Yazid ar-Riyahi (r.a) is an example of redemption and forgiveness from the Day of Ashura. Hurr (r.a) began his story in Karbala in the team against Imam Hussain (a.s). On the Day of Ashura, Hurr (r.a) realised the errors in his ways and sought forgiveness from Imam Hussain (a.s). Imam Hussain (a.s) forgave Hurr (r.a) and he stood valiantly on the side of Imam Hussain (a.s).

Hurr (r.a) is an excellent example of standing with the truth and seeking forgiveness, regardless of how difficult it may be.

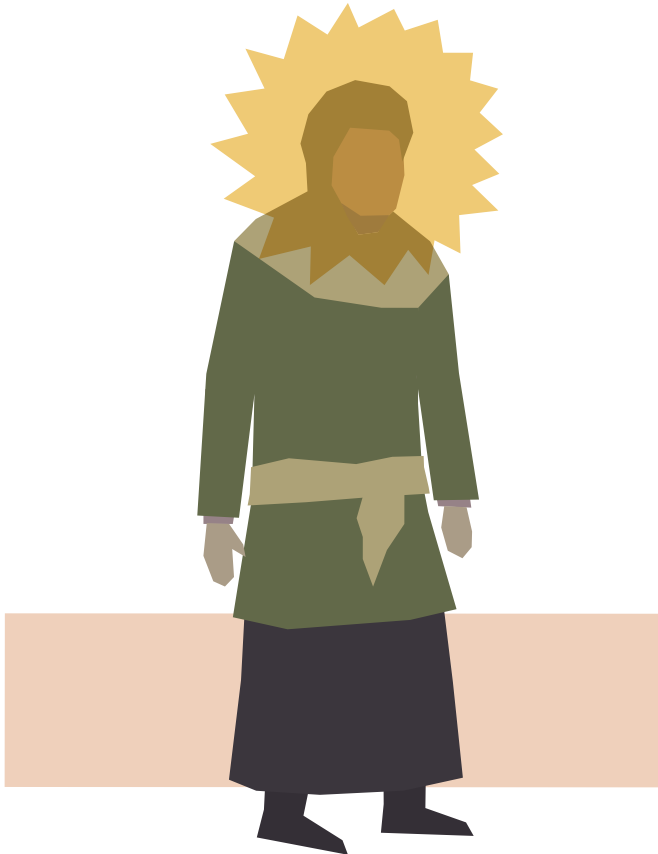


Qasim ibn al Hassan (a.s)

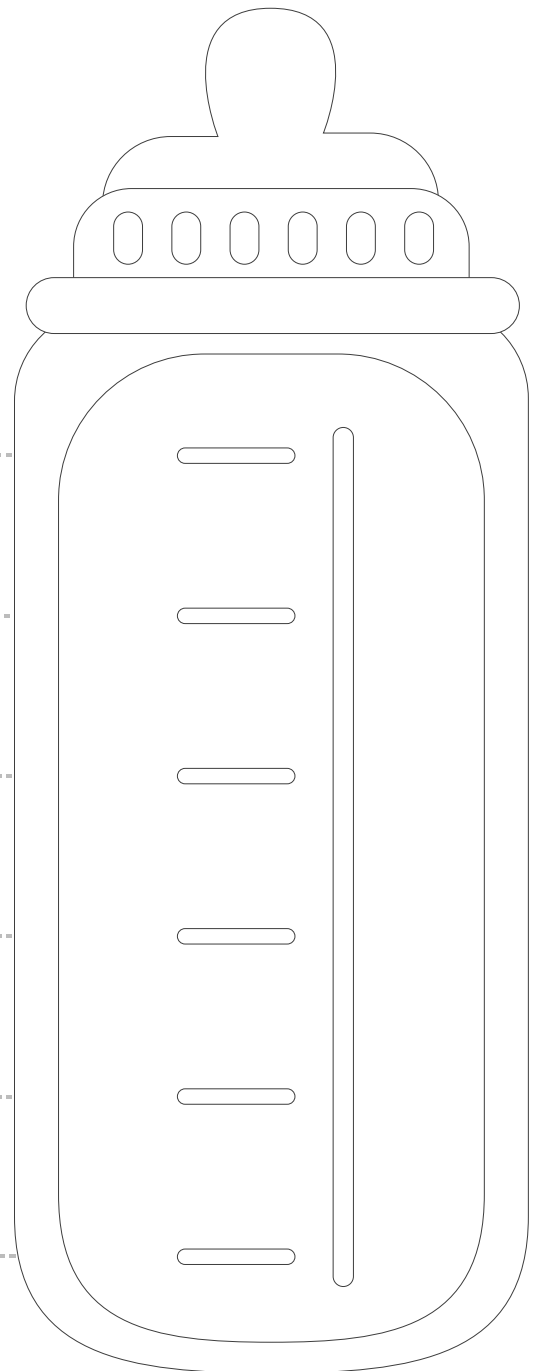

Bibi Sakina bint al Hussain (s.a)

Sayyeda Ruqayyah (s.a) was the youngest daughter of Imam Hussain (a.s). She was very thirsty in the hot dessert of Karbala so she asked her uncle Hazrat Abbas (a.s) to bring her some water. Bibi Sakina's (s.a) uncle was killed by Yazid's army whist trying to collect water for the children.

Hazrat Abbas (a.s)

Hazrat Abbas (a.s) was the dear brother of Imam Hussain (a.s) who bravely supported and helped Imam Hussain (a.s) on the 10th of Muharram. His death was very painful for Imam Hussain (a.s). Imam Hussain (a.s) said his back had now been broken when Hazrat Abbas (a.s) was martyred.

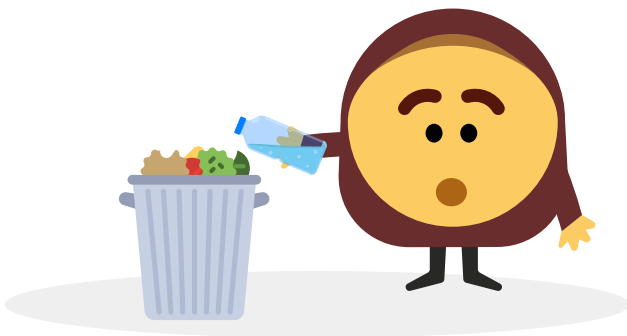


Water Footprint

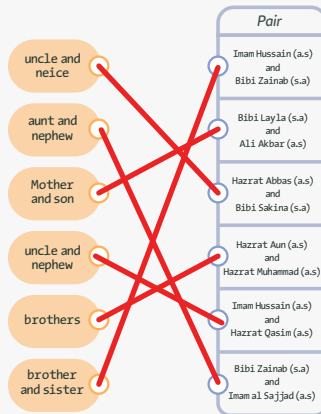

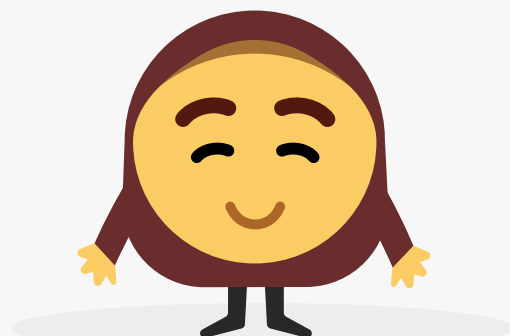
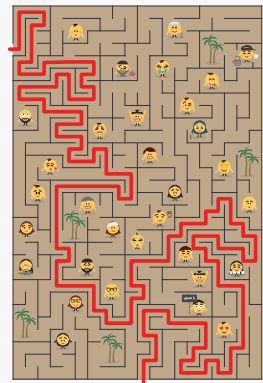
