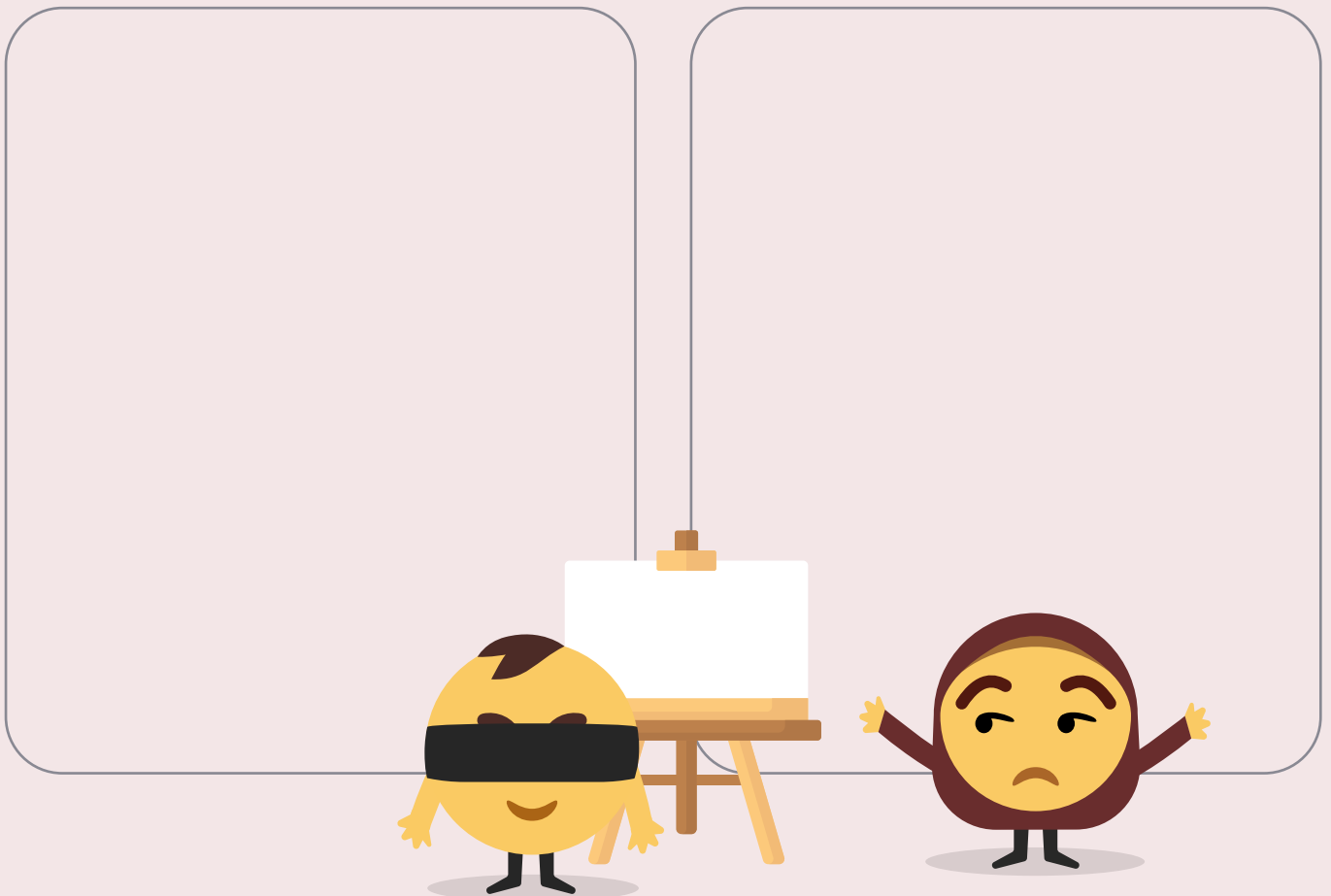
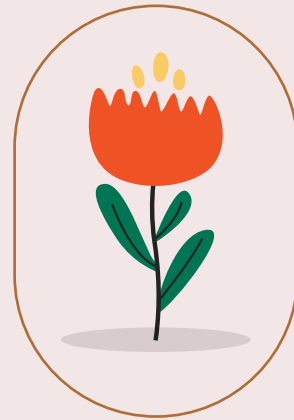
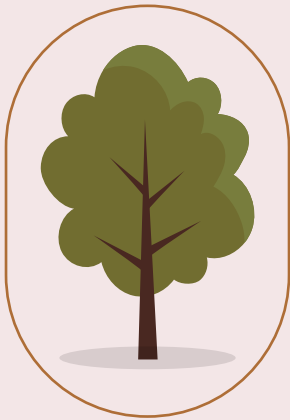


See the blessings of Allah (swt)!
